Prepare to Teach

In today's story, God sent Moses back to Pharaoh to ask for permission to let the Israelites go into the desert to worship God. Pharaoh knew that to let the Israelites go meant he would be letting go of the slave labor. He didn't want this to happen. The Bible says, "But I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and through I multiply my signs and wonders in the land of Egypt, Pharaoh will not listen to you." This was all part of God's big plan to show His mighty power to the Egyptians and the Israelites. Although this is a lengthy passage, if you haven't read it recently, take time to read Exodus 7-12 and observe God's power!

- Which of the ten plagues can you name?
- Whose power was shown in every plague?
- What happened after the last plague? What did God tell His people to do?
- Finally what did Pharaoh finally say? GO!
