Prepare to Teach

Today begins our summer series "Moses on the Move." Each week we will learn about a different part of Moses' life. This week we see how God miraculously spared Moses' life from birth. This story has always been a favorite for children because it is about a baby! But can you imagine, as a parent, what it must have been like to put your precious baby boy in a basket and float him down the Nile River? What an amazing God we serve! God orchestrated each event in this story to be part of His bigger plan to save Israel from their life of slavery in Egypt. You will be encouraged this summer as you follow the story of Moses along with your preschooler.
