Read the Beginner's Bible account of Genesis 1 on pages 7-13. Days 5 is on page 12...

Creation Book Day 5

Have your child color water at the bottom of the page and at the top color clouds and a blue sky. Then have them put the stickers of the birds and the fish in the sea and the water.

Talk

Use these questions to help you review the story with your child:

- Who created the world?
- What did God create on days 1 and 2? (Light, Darkness, Sky, Water)
- What did God create on days 3 and 4?? (Dry Land, Seas, Sun, Moon, Stars and Planets)
- What did God create in today's lesson, on day 5? (fish and birds)
- What did God say after each day? (It was good.)
