Here are some of the highlights:

WE PRAY to abide with God - if we don't abide well, our mission and vision will struggle.

WE PRAY because God said, "For My house will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples." (Isaiah 56:7)

WE PRAY because it is good and right & it unleashes the power & the presence & the tenderness of God in our lives.

When we abide with God through prayer:

- we seek His face more than His hands
- we seek His presence more than His presents
- · His desires become our desires
- we will begin to pray in accordance with His will because our hearts will align with His heart
